

Class Descriptions:

(Bolded Divisions are recognized by Freedom Horse Show

Association, you do not need to be a member to show in the division)

Leadline: Riders 6 yrs and under. May cross enter into Walk-Trot.

1. Lead Line – Walk on line
2. Lead Line – Walk/Trot on line
3. Lead Line Advanced – Off Lead Line

Walk/Trot: Riders 10 yrs and under. May cross enter into any Walk-Trot

4. Walk Equitation
5. Walk/Trot - Equitation
6. Walk/Trot – Pleasure

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 and under, judged on the rider. To jump 4 crossrails.

7. Walk/Trot
8. Walk/Trot/Canter
9. Over 4 Crossrails

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 10 and under, judged on the mount. To jump 2'

Beginner Rider Equitation: Open to anyone in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. May be split. May cross enter Pleasure, Low Children's, Low Adult, or . Long Stirrup

Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to Adult Amateur riders only. Judged on the rider. May cross enter Pleasure, Baby Green, or Novice Equitation

18. Over Fences- 8 Crossrails

Junior Equitation: Open to Junior riders only. Judged on rider. May be split into 13 & Under and 14-17. Ponies to jump 2'3", Horses to jump 2'6".

Pleasure Pony/Horse: Open to all riders on ponies or horses. Judged on mount. Ponies to jump 2', Horses to jump 2'6"

Modified Hunter: Open to horses or ponies, all riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'.

Low Children's/Children's Pony Hunter: Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. Low and S/M to jump 2'. Large to jump 2'6".

Low Children's/Children's Hunter Horse: Open to Junior riders on horses. Judged on mount. Low to jump 2'6". Children's to jump 3'

Low Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders. Judged on mount All to jump 2'6".

Baby Green Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Open to all riders. Judged on mount. Ponies all to jump 2', Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting in comers not to be penalized.

1. Classes are \$20 each. There will be a \$10 Office Fee and \$10 EMT fee added to each entry. Checks should be made payable to "Durango Farm." If you preenter, then \$10 Office fee is waived.
2. PRE-ENTRIES can be emailed to: email:Cactusbelle6@aol.com
3. Fees must be paid before numbers are issued. Parents or guardians must accompany minors when filling registration forms.
4. Approved protective headgear and shoes with heels are required when mounted.
5. Martingales are not permitted in flat classes.
6. There will be a short schooling break before each division.
7. Outdoor Ring will be open for additional schooling
8. The horse show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide, or add classes as they deem appropriate: (3)- Riders are required to fill a class for placing ribbon awards. (4)- Riders are required in each class of a division for Championship ribbons to be awarded.
9. Durango Farm, Managers, Staff, and/or Volunteers will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, or damage which occurs to any rider, horse, or equipment before, during, or after the horse show.
10. **All activities on show grounds are subject to the NJ State Equine Law**
11. Non-negotiable checks be will subject to a \$50 processing fee.
